

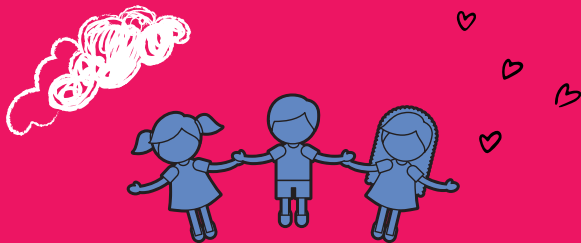


# We *HAVE* to talk about it!
